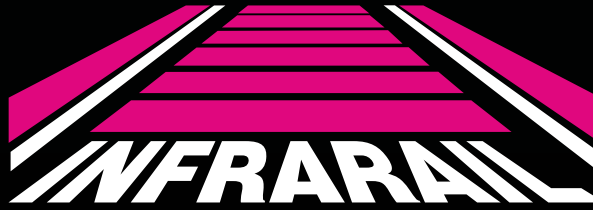

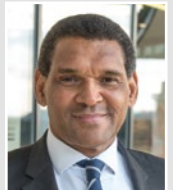

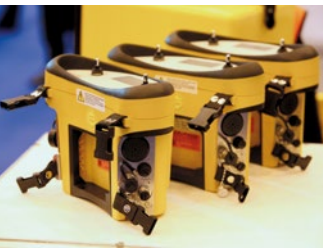

How to get to ExCeL London

ExCeL is easily reached by a variety of public transport systems as well as by road.

BY ROAD

Use postcode E16 1DR for your SatNav in order to drive to ExCeL, which boasts 3,700 car parking spaces onsite.

BY TRAIN

London is connected by rail to all major cities in Great Britain, with frequent services to all corners of the country. Eurostar also operates regular train services to Brussels, Paris and beyond from St Pancras International.

London's main rail stations are:

- Charing Cross (27 mins)
- Euston (32 mins)
- Liverpool Street (26 mins)
- London Bridge (16 mins)
- King's Cross / St Pancras International (32 mins)
- Moorgate (26 mins)
- Paddington (32 mins)
- Victoria (34 mins)
- Waterloo (19 mins)

All of these stations are served by the London Underground network, providing links which will take you to ExCeL London.

BY TUBE

For Infrarail, which is accessed via hall entrances S4 and S5, please use the Tube's Jubilee Line to **CANNING TOWN STATION**, from which frequent Docklands Light Railways (DLR) services run to **CUSTOM HOUSE STATION**.

BY AIR

London is the best connected city in the world and can be reached in less time, from more places, than any other location. London has six international airports. If you are flying into the capital to attend an event at ExCeL, we recommend using London City Airport if you can as it is less than a mile from the venue.

From London City Airport, it takes just 5 minutes by taxi or 15 minutes by DLR (Docklands Light Railway) to get to ExCeL. The airport has 350 flights per day, from over 40 international destinations including Amsterdam, Dublin, Madrid, Nice, Frankfurt, Rome and Zurich.

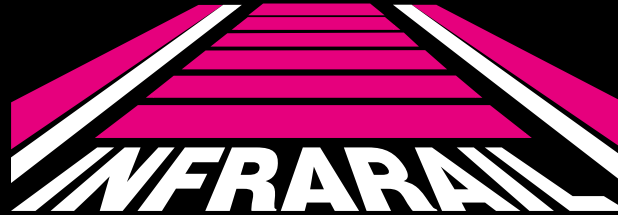
